Licensed as a nursing home for chronically ill infants and children



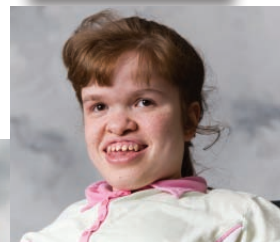
1974

A new facility was constructed



1988

A new addition was constructed  
*This gave St. Margaret's the space necessary to care for children up to 16 years old.*



1999

In January, St. Margaret's Center became part of the Center for the Disabled Family of Services. In July, the Daylight program for adults opened, and in September, the Young Adult Unit opened.  
*This allowed St. Margaret's to provide a continuum of care to residents beyond the age of 16.*



2008

2010

The 36 bed addition, which will create new employment opportunities, is scheduled to open late summer. The expansion will add two respite beds, 16 beds designated for pediatric residents in need of mechanical ventilation, and 18 specialty pediatric beds to the residential facility.
