The expansion will decrease the necessity to use acute hospital facilities, and be economical for the health care system. The advantage for patients is they remain with the staff who know them best."

"The expansion of St. Margaret's Center is an exciting time for all of us. We will be able to offer additional services for our medically fragile residents as well as those children in the community. This continuum of care is such a comfort for our families. In addition, we will offer a transition from hospital to home for those children who require some extra time to reach a level of medical stability and who can receive that care at St. Margaret's in a non-hospital environment."

1967

Licensed as a nursing home for chronically ill infants and children



1974

A new facility was constructed



1988

A new addition was constructed This gave St. Margaret's the space necessary to care for children up to 16 years old.



1999

In January, St. Margaret's Center became part of the Center for the Disabled Family of Services. In July, the Daylight program for adults opened, and in September, the Young Adult Unit opened. This allowed St. Margaret's to provide a continuum of care to residents beyond the age of 16.

The 36 bed addition, which will create new employment opportunities, is scheduled to open in August. The expansion will add two respite beds, 16 beds designated for pediatric residents in need of mechanical ventilation, and 18 specialty pediatric beds to the residential facility.
